THE VACCINE IS OFFERED FREE OF CHARGE TO:

People at higher risk of complications due to their age or their health condition :

- People aged from 6 months to 74 years with a medical condition or a chronic disease.
- People aged 75 years and over.
- Children and teenagers (aged less than 6 months to 17 years) on a prolonged treatment with acetylsalicylic acid.
- Residents of all ages in residential and long-term care centers as well as intermediate resources.
- Pregnant women with a medical condition or a chronic disease (the vaccine can be given regardless of the stage of pregnancy).
- Healthy pregnant women who are in the second or third trimester of pregnancy (thirteen weeks and above).
- People living in remote or isolated communities.
- Travelers with a chronic illness or condition who will be traveling to an area where influenza viruses are circulating (tropics: year-round; southern hemisphere: April to September).

People at risk of transmitting influenza to people at higher risk of complications:

- People living in the same household as people at higher risk of complications (including children aged 0-6 months who cannot be vaccinated) and those who care for them at home (caregivers).
- Healthcare workers who have frequent contact
